DID YOU KNOW...?

- Every year Birch Mountain Sports (BMS) must submit a membership list and fee to CCSAM in order to be listed as a cross-country ski club and be eligible for funding. Membership to the CCSAM is necessary to access their insurance coverage during race events as well as the Jackrabbit Ski Program.
- BMS is gearing up to be a Biathlon ski club. We are setting up a shooting range and an athletics program. The introduction of Biathlon will not alter other activities and events historically held at Birch Ski Area.
- The Jackrabbit ski instructors volunteer their time to teach the jackrabbit programs.
- Gas for grooming, cookies, hot chocolate, general maintenance of facilities (e.g. hot water tank) and general maintenance of grooming equipment is paid for by the club. This means that all money collected through registration goes directly to operating costs.
- In previous years BMS has managed to pay-off our snowmobile and groomer, roller and brushcutter. These were necessary purchases to provide the high standard of trail conditions we are all used to.
- Other sources of income are through the efforts of our canteen, trail fee donations and from casual skiers as well as fees collected from the events that we host.
